Registration is held at the Robert J. DiPietro Community Center and the Laurel Armory Anderson-Murphy Community Center during hours of operation. Internet registration is available for some programs once your account has been created. We strongly encourage new customers to visit one of our community centers to create an account. After your account has been created, you may register for classes/programs online at: www.Cityoflaurel.org/parks under our 'Classes & Registration' page.

Please visit our department's Facebook page or City website for the most up-to-date program information. You must be registered to participate, unless a program listing states that no registration is required. Registration will be accepted through the first week of class if space is available. The City of Laurel Department of Parks and Recreation welcomes the participation of individuals with disabilities into all programs. The City will fully comply with the American with Disabilities Act in making reasonable accommodations to encourage participation.

Fees

Checks are only accepted for certain activities. Persons paying City of Laurel property taxes pay resident fees. Fees include materials unless otherwise noted. No fee reductions will be made for missed classes. Scholarships are available for low-income City resident families for some programs. The City also offers vouchers for low income City resident families that may be used towards recreation programs for children, youth and teens with other agencies. This year, the City of Laurel Department of Parks & Recreation celebrates its' 60th Anniversary! Beginning in January of 1965, Judith Nigh was hired to determine the recreation and park needs of the community and to make recommendations for the development and implementation of a Parks and Recreation Department. With the passage of state enabling legislation in May 1965, the City adopted Ordinance Number 449 establishing the Laurel Department of Parks & Recreation.

Fast forward 60 years and today the Department of Parks & Recreation has grown in size to... 29 full-time employees, over 60 seasonal and auxiliary staff, 3 gyms, 2 outdoor pools, 1 dog park, 2 community centers, 10 playgrounds, 15 parks, and the maintenance of over 280 acres of land. The Department proudly continues its original mission to establish, maintain and operate a comprehensive program for parks and recreation and to ensure the delivery of a variety of leisure services and facilities that enhance and enrich the quality of life for the citizens and residents of the City of Laurel.

This winter and throughout the year, join us in celebrating our 60th Anniversary—whether it's attending a holiday event, registering for a new program, or even taking a stroll through one of our parks. 
