

Community Redevelopment Authority (CRA)

One Hundredth and eighth Meeting

Wednesday, April 16, 2025 – 4:00 PM

Proceedings:

The CRA meeting being held at Gude Mansion was called to order at 4:03 pm with Chairwoman Crary presiding. Roll was called with Donna Crary, Chairwoman; Carlos Lancaster, CRA Member and Sean LeVere, CRA Member. Nathaniel Foreman, City Solicitor, Miles Roesner, IT GIS Specialist and Sadaf Parveen, Economic Development Coordinator were also in attendance.

Motion to approve CRA meeting minutes of March 19, 2025. Carlos motioned; Sean seconded. Motion carried on a unanimous roll call vote 3-0.

Old Business:

a) Mapping Pathway Around Lake to Mansion

- Miles Roesner, IT GIS Specialist presented the QR code that links to the map online. The QR code takes you to the digital map which shows the different trails and mile markings.
- Chairwoman Crary suggested to put the sign with the QR code and Mansion logo on a brown wooden post and to keep the signage low, so it is visible to all people. Also, it was recommended to angle the QR code for easier scanning and convenience for participants.
- The committee members discussed adding a description to the online map as an introduction and purpose of the map.
- The digital map is to be updated to include a feature for participants to track their progress as they walk the various trails.

New Business:

a) City Events

- Sadaf Parveen shared a reminder that the Farmers Market 2025 season is approaching, and the first Market date is on May 1st at the Lot, 378 Main Street from 3 – 7 pm.
