INSTRUCTIONS – VOTE BY MAIL

Enclosed: Mail-in Ballot, Secret Ballot Envelope, and Return Envelope marked with: **(CONFIDENTIAL MATERIALS-LAUREL BOARD OF ELECTIONS OFFICIAL VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT)** with the Oath of Mail-in Voter on the back.

WARNING: FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS WILL INVALIDATE THE BALLOT.

1. Carefully examine the ballot before marking. Using **blue or black ink only**, mark your ballot by darkening the oval to the left of the candidate's name. Do not vote for more candidates than the number specified over the names of candidates for each office. Do not put a check mark or X in the oval by a candidate. The ballot must be marked secretly. Do not sign your name or put any mark of identification on the ballot.
2. Enclose the ballot in the Secret Ballot Envelope and seal. Please be sure that the Secret Ballot Envelope contains nothing, but one Mail-in Ballot marked by you.

Enclose the Secret Ballot Envelope in the Return Envelope with the Oath of Mail-in Voter on the back. Complete the Oath and seal the envelope. **The Oath must be completed, or your ballot will not count.**

3. Mail your voted ballot immediately. Ballots not postmarked by Election Day, Tuesday, November 4, 2025, will not be counted. Vote by Mail Ballots can also be dropped in one of the City of Laurel Drop Boxes located at one of the following locations:
